### **Livelihood Activities**

#### **Urban Skill Training Program**

Government of India has launched DAY NULM, also known as Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission, as a flagship initiative to improve the employment and standard of living for the urban poor in our country, The DAY-NULM programme, SRET is assisting the PIA's to implement 2050 candidates trained in the Telecom, Apparel and IT sectors and job placement for the 70% of the youth which covers the Chennai, Villupuram, Tiruvallur, Ranipet, Thanjavur, Tiruvarur and Nagapattinam districts of Tamil Nadu.

#### Rural Skill Training Program

The Ministry of Rural Development is implementing the Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), which aims to up skill underprivileged rural youth and provide them with jobs. We have partnered with PIAs and implemented the training on Two Wheeler Services Technician, Retails Sales associate and Domestic Data Entry Operator for 1530 candidates with placement 72 %. We have implemented the training in Tirvallur, Thiruvanamalai and Villupuram districts of Tamil Nadu.

#### NASD - SRET Skill Training Program

SRET is an authorized Training Provider (ATP) of National Association of Skill Development which is under MCA and Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India. SRET has 2 training facilities in Chennai district, one Training facility at Royapuram the another one training facility at T.Nagar. We have collaborated with the corporates & PIAs have conducted a three-month placement linked certificate skill training programme at Kilpauk , chennai on "Assistant Spa Therapy" for 33 unemployed youth heading from North and North East of India. All youth were placed in the Tony & Guy Parlour outlets across Tamil Nadu. We also conducted the training on Self Employed Tailoring for 110 women at Royapuram, chennai
